#### WHAT IS CAMP CONNER?

Poland Summer Recreation at Camp Connor is now in its 3rd year! Camp Connor is a day camp with approximately 12 acres of land, including a beach front, large field, wooded area, picnic area, playground, peninsula, and buildings. We also have access to our neighbor's Camp Tall Pines basketball court and beachfront for launching our kayaks and canoes. Camp Connor is located off of route 26, address: 70 Connor Lane. (Connor Lane is a dirt road, that provides access to Camp Tall Pines, Poland Spring Campground and a few residents)
